Accordingly, the submission of printed copies to the GPPB-TSO <u>SHALL NO LONGER BE ACCEPTED.</u>

The deadline for the submission of the FY 2020 Updated/Supplemental APP (for changes within the second semester), FY 2020 PMR (second semester), and FY 2021 APP, were extended from their original date of submission to <u>31 March 2021</u>. Meanwhile, the submission of the FY 2020 APCPI results was set on <u>31 March 2021</u>.

Upon electronic submission of the foregoing reports, PEs should be able to receive an auto-generated acknowledgment receipt from the Performance Monitoring Division of the GPPB-TSO. Said AUTO-GENERATED ACKNOWLEDGMENT RECEIPT IS THE ONLY ACCEPTABLE PROOF OF SUBMISSION. If no auto-generated acknowledgment receipt was received within one hour from electronic submission, the PE should re-submit its report to the same electronic mail address. If no auto-generated acknowledgment receipt is still received after the re-submission, the PE representative should call the Performance Monitoring Division (PMD) of the GPPB-TSO to validate his/her submission.
